
# FOOD WASTE





- 1. Participants are encouraged to utilize a reusable sealable container for the transportation of the food waste to a recycling center and not use composting bags.
- 2. All food waste must be removed from its packaging.
- Examples of acceptable food waste include meat, poultry, fish, bones, eggs, table scraps, fruits, vegetables, bread, pasta, grains, coffee grounds and tea bags.
- The acceptable food waste can be comingled together.
- **Examples of items NOT** acceptable include: cardboard, cups, food wrap, gloves, grease, ice cream, ice cream cartons, liquids, juice, juice cartons, milk, napkins, paper towels, paper, pizza delivery boxes, pet waste, plastic bags, take out containers, plastic tubs, styrofoam, utensils, tissues or garbage.
- 6. All food waste will be inspected. Items considered not acceptable will be rejected.
- 7. Available at Grapevine Road and South Berkeley Recycling Centers only.

#### **ALUMINUM CANS. FOIL & PIE PANS**

- 1. Must be empty and rinsed out.
- 2. May be crushed.
- 3. Deposit cans in proper bin.

#### **BI-METAL, STEEL & TIN CANS**

- 1. Must be empty & rinsed out.
- 2. Deposit cans in proper bin.

#### **CORRUGATED CARDBOARD**

- 1. Must be separated from all other forms of paper.
- 2. Place in designated container.

#### **GLASS BOTTLES & JARS**

**NO LIGHT BULBS. WINDOW GLASS. FLAT GLASS. COOKWARE OR** DINNERWARE ACCEPTED.

- 1. Clear, brown, green, yellow & blue.
- 2. Glass must be sorted by color.
- 3. Containers must be empty & rinsed out.
- 4. Lids & caps must be removed.
- 5. Gold glass goes in with brown glass.
- 6. Blue glass goes in with green glass.
- 7. Deposit in the proper bins.

#### **PAPER PRODUCTS**

**NO WAX PAPER. WAX CUPS. & NO WAX MILK CARTONS.** 

Cereal Boxes, Newspapers, Magazines, Catalogs, Computer Paper, Junk Mail, Phone Books, Paperboard & Other Paper Products. BUNDLED OR PLACED IN A PAPER BAG.

- 1. DO NOT USE PLASTIC BAGS.
- 2. Place paper in designated container.

#### **APPLIANCES & SCRAP METAL**

#### **ABSOLUTELY NO PROPANE BOTTLES ACCEPTED.**

Washers, Dryers, Stoves, Air Conditioners, Lawn Mowers, Chainsaws, Dehumidifiers, Aluminum, Brass, Copper, Refrigerators, & Freezers are accepted.

#### **BATTERIES: DRY CELL, LEAD ACID &** RECHARGEABLE

- 1. Separate dry cell batteries from rechargeable batteries.
- 2. Deposit in proper area.

#### BOOKS

#### **NO SCHOOL YEARBOOKS ACCEPTED.**

1. Deposit hard or soft back books into yellow container marked "Books".

#### **CLOTHING/SHOES**

- 1. Clothes or other textiles of any age, condition or manufacturer accepted.
- 2. Place in plastic bag and deposit in yellow containers.

#### **ELECTRONICS**

- 1. Televisions, computers, monitors, laptops, VCR's, printers, DVD players, phones and electrical wiring are acceptable.
- 2. Smoke detectors are not acceptable.
- 3. Donations are suggested for each television and computer monitor.

#### **FLUORESCENT LAMPS**

- 1. CFL lamps and long tubes that are 4 foot long or less are acceptable.
- 2. DO NOT BREAK GLASS.
- 3. Deposit in proper area.

#### **LUMBER & WOODEN PALLETS** (CLEAN)

NO PAINTED, STAINED, ROTTED WOOD, **FURNITURE. LAMINATED WOOD OR PRESSURE** TREATED LUMBER ACCEPTED.

#### **PLASTIC BAGS**

- 1. Bags must be stamped #2 or #4.
- 2. Standard trash or garbage bags are not accepted.
- 3. Place bags in proper trailer.

#### PLASTIC CONTAINERS #1 thru #7 NO TRASH OR GARBAGE BAGS ACCEPTED.

## 1. Plastic must be stamped #1, #2, #3, #4, #5,

- #6, or #7. 2. Styrofoam, black colored plastic and rigid
- plastic are not acceptable.
- 3. Buckets, plant containers and storage tubs are not acceptable.
- 4. Place items in clear bag provided at the trailer.

#### **USED ANTIFREEZE**

- 1. Any color accepted.
- 2. See attendant prior to disposal of liquid.
- 3. There is a five gallon limit per visit.
- 4. Do not recycle the empty plastic container.

#### **USED OIL**

- 1. Engine, hydraulic and transmission fluid accepted.
- 2. Oil mixed with water is not accepted.
- 3. See attendant prior to disposal of liquid
- 4. Do not recycle the empty plastic container.

### YARD WASTE / CHRISTMAS TREES

NO STUMPS OR ASHES ACCEPTED.

Leaves, Grass, Brush, Sawdust, Weeds, Vegetables, Sod, Flowers, Garden Residue & Christmas Trees.

- 1. Christmas Trees must be free of lights & ornaments.
- 2. Yard waste (without brush) may be comingled.
- 3. Brush must be less than 6 inches thick & less than 10 feet long.
- 4. Remove yard waste from all bags.
- 5. Pay the mandatory processing fee for brush.
