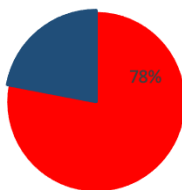

Where does your vehicle tax money go?

Over 75% of vehicle and real estate property taxes paid each year by Berkeley County taxpayers go to our public schools in Berkeley County.



■ Public Schools



What does your vehicle taxes support?

Public Safety Services, such as School Resource Officers, Paid Firefighters and Law Enforcement.

You may be considered a West Virginia resident if ...

- You are registered to vote in West Virginia
- You have a child, or children, enrolled in public schools in the state
- You are receiving public assistance from West Virginia
- You have resided or continuously remained in West Virginia for a period exceeding 30 days, except for infrequent or brief absences
- You have filed for a Homestead tax exemption in West Virginia



PENALTY FOR FAILURE TO PROPERLY REGISTER YOUR VEHICLE

"Any person violating the provisions of this article is guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not more than \$500; and upon a second or subsequent conviction thereof, shall be fined not more than \$500, or confined in the county or regional jail not more than six months, or both."
